



Cost of Online Courses

Online courses with a Regular Outreach Course attribute provide an excellent option for students who require flexibility in course schedules during the fall or spring semesters or have to be away from campus during the summer. However, these courses do come at an additional cost, so it is important for students to know the costs associated with an online course in advance. These costs include:

- Regular block or per-credit-hour tuition rates
- All university-wide/mandatory fees associated with on campus courses (*Student Activity Fee-General, Student Activity Fee-Athletics, Student Facility Fee-General, Student Facility Fee-Campus Recreation, Student Development Fee, Health Services Fee, Advising and Assessment Fee, Library Automation & Technology Fee, University Technology Infrastructure Maintenance Fee, Academic Facilities Fee, Academic Records Fee, Daily O'Collegian Fee, Transit/Parking Services Fee, Life Safety & Security Fee, Academic Excellence Fee, and Student Union Renovation Fee*)
- All college based fees associated with on campus classes (e.g. college technology and program fees)
- An additional college based online course fee

New students entering summer 2017 or after will also be assessed a Campus Infrastructure Fee of \$13.00 per credit hour. Graduate Masters, Graduate Certificate and Graduate Special students will be assessed a Graduate College Program fee of \$2.50 per credit hour. Graduate Doctorate and Doctoral Specialist students will be assessed a Graduate College Program fee of \$3.00 per credit hour. Additional course based fees associated with specific classes are not listed and might be incurred.

*Students paying the block rate will be charged per credit hour tuition and mandatory fee rate for anything over 18 hours.

**Graduate Nonresident students in a 100% online degree program will be charged a tuition rate of \$360.00 per credit hour.
